Review and Approval of the Minutes: Approved as written.

State MaCCRA Legislative Report: J. Mattingly noted state MaCCRA is actively lobbying for SB488 and HB 424 and we have written letters of support to our legislators. We will also send letters to members of the Senate and House committees in which hearings have been held. Select members of this Executive Committee will meet with J. Prince regarding conflicting organizational support of these bills.

Candidates Forum: Date: April 22; Time: 7:00 pm; Place: Auditorium. Candidates for the following legislative positions will be invited: Baltimore County Executive, (currently there are 5 Democrats and 2 Republican who have filed); Baltimore County Council-District 3 (1 Democrat and 2 Republicans including N. Mangione); State Senate -District 42 (2 Dems, 4 Reps); House of Delegates-District 42A (1 Dem and 3 Rep); States Atty (3 Democrats). Key issues will be planning and zoning.

Will consider having another forum following the primaries.

MaCCRA in Annapolis Day: Held on February 26, 2026 with 10 residents from Broadmead attending. A. Perkins visited with Sen. West and he met with the delegation from Broadmead. Residents interacted with those from other CCRCs. Overall attendance was strong and the day was deemed successful.

Speakers: Will investigate Sen West and Delegate Mangione to give an end-of-session presentation in May. We may also ask representatives from District 42 B and C. At June Annual Meeting we will ask FBI representative to speak on scams. No programs in July or August.
