The Barn Sale at Broadmead provides a service to new residents, both before and after they move in, by accepting selected items that are no longer needed. Such items:

- Books
- Watches & Jewelry
- Clothing
- Knick-knacks

All revenue from the subsequent sale of such items goes to support the activities of the Broadmead Residents Association (BRA). In so doing, the Barn Sale provides the largest source of funds in support of BRA programs; these include concerts, lectures, shows, classes and other events that enrich the lives of residents.

Not only does this assist new residents in recycling those items, but it helps build a sense of community on the part of participating volunteers. Residents, staff, families and friends are all able to make purchases at very reasonable prices.



The Barn Sale accepts donations based on their potential salability – those that are in good working order, not in need of repair, clean and not stained – overall in very good condition, something that you would be happy to give to a friend or loved one.
