Join us for 300 years of history on a live-narrated tour of Baltimore's world-famous Inner Harbor. Come see how Baltimore's wonderful waterfront connects the past with the present and Baltimore to the rest of the world.

Schedule:

Date of Trip: Saturday, June 20, 2026

9:00am - Load the Freedom Car Bus at Lower Level

(Drop off on Pratt Street; there is about a 500' walk to the Constellation where the boat is docked)

10:00am - Boat Tour Starts (lasting 1.5 hours)

11:30am - Return to Freedom Car Bus to return to Broadmead

This trip is rain or shine (only cancelled by Baltimore Heritage if the water is dangerous to be on)

Cost for Boat Tour & Transportation: \$48/person
(non-refundable & billed to July 1 monthly Broadmead bill)

(A portion of the cost is being sponsored by the BRA)

The bus and boat are not handicap accessible for scooters and wheelchairs - rollators are okay)
